Eligibility Guidelines for Programs/Services

Health Care Programs: Community Events, Health Fairs, Presentations, Outreach/Enrollment

Health Care Programs must target the District's population that meets either of the following:

1. Criteria B through E listed below in the Health Care Services section or
2. Must be qualified for the State of Florida Medicaid program and meet the residency requirement in section C below.

Health Care Services:

Criteria for **Health Care Services** being provided:

A. Services Provided

1. Must be non-elective/medically necessary (Not Preventative).

B. Citizenship

1. Must be a US citizen or a lawful legal resident.

C. Residency

1. Must be a resident of the District.
 - A. To be a resident the individual must have resided in the District for the past six months.
 - B. Homeless people must provide a current valid homeless coalition card.

D. Income

1. Prior six months of household income must be at or below 200% of the Annual Federal Poverty guidelines.

E. Assets

1. Household assets must not exceed \$2,000. \$150,000 will be allowed for the individual's primary residence and \$10,000 for vehicles.

F. Other Insurance

1. Have no other available health insurance benefits and have not declined health insurance through their or their spouses' employer.
2. Must have proof of applying through the Affordable Care Act.

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
